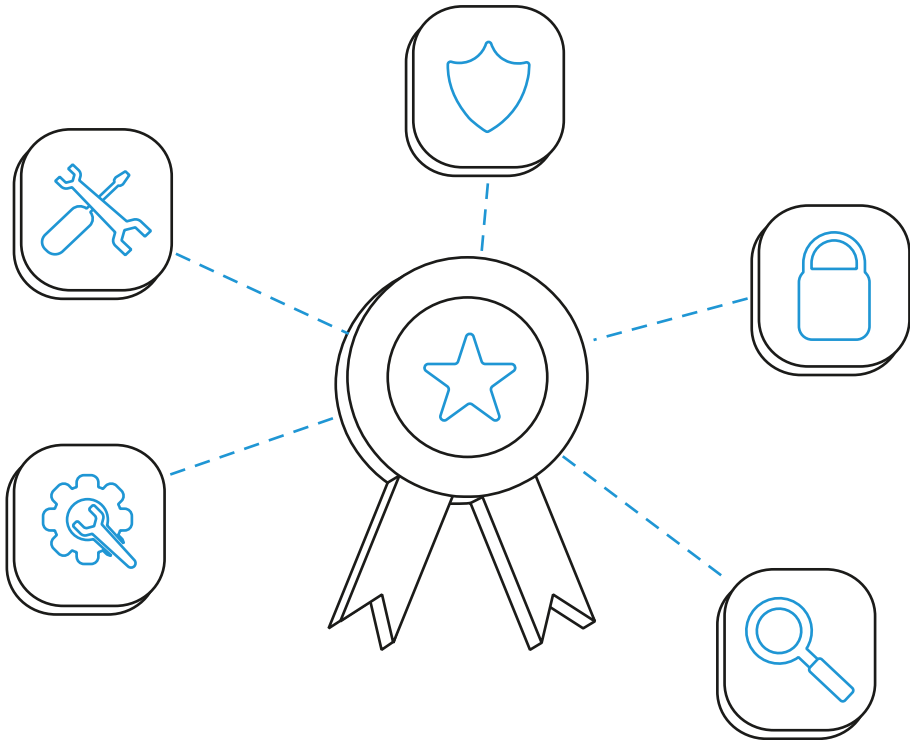
What is the CPSTIC?

The CPSTIC is the ICT Security Products & Services Catalog from the National Cryptologic Center (CCN).



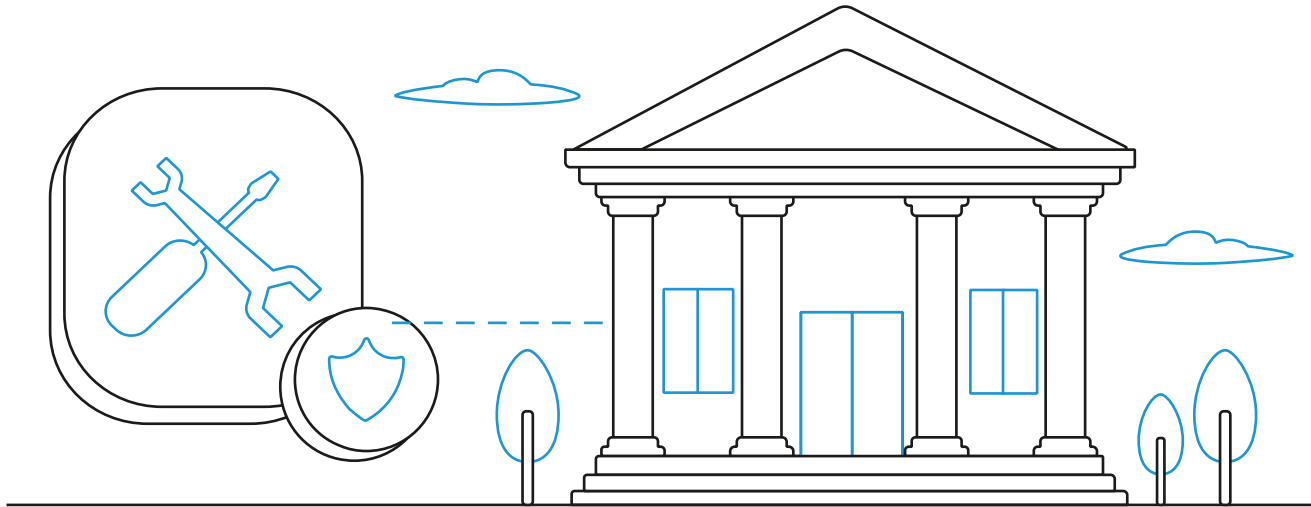
Goal

The main purpose of the CPSTIC is to offer a set of reference ICT products & services, whose security functionalities have been certified. The products on the CPSTIC provide a **minimum trust level** to the final user in the product or services purchased.



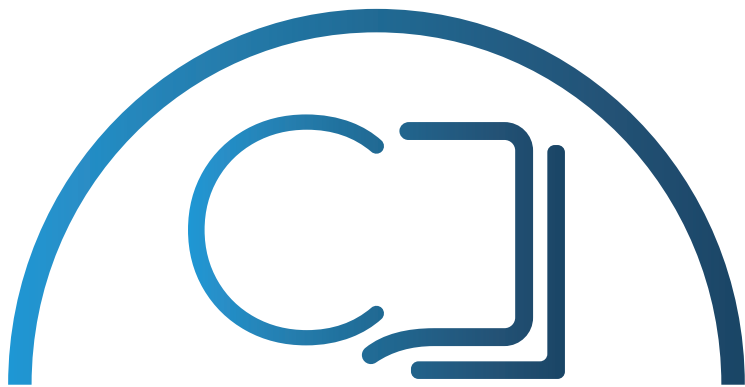
Target

Facilitating public agencies and private entities the adquisition of security trusted products and services for ICT systems.



How many lists does the catalog have?

The CPSTIC is divided in three products and services lists:



Qualified
Suitable for low range information systems **from the Esquema Nacional de Seguridad (ENS)**.



Approved
Suitable for the **classified Information handling**.



Governance & Compliance
Facilitate management & implementation of security measures from an Information System.

Which type of products and services are included in the CPSTIC?

The lists of services & products are each divided into **general categories** that, in turn, encompass **product families**. For each families, the CCN has defined a set of security requirements that a product or service must meet in order to be included in the CPSTIC.
